

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

Ephesians 2:8-9For by grace you have been saved through faith and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God not the result of works, so that no one may boast. 10For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand to be our way of life.

Article IV Book of Concord (Lutheran Confessions) "Faith alone justifies because we receive the forgiveness of sins and the Holy Spirit by faith alone. The reconciled are accounted righteous and children of God not on account of their own purity but by mercy on account of Christ, if they grasp this mercy by faith. Thus the scriptures testify that we are accounted righteous by faith." Pg. 119

We will be celebrating Reformation Day on Sunday, October 27th at 10:30 am. A lot of people criticized Martin Luther for breaking up the unity of the church in the 16th century. There were divisions before with the East and West which caused a split in 1054 and there were divisions throughout. Martin Luther was not perfect but he did not want to start a new church and was actually excommunicated at the time of the Reformation by challenging abuses in the church that took the focus off the good news of Jesus life, death and resurrection. He was against Indulgences and focusing on your own works takes the focus off of the gospel. When you can't hear clearly that Jesus died for your sins and this is my body and blood for you then you are uncertain of God's love and salvation. This was the heart of the Reformation teaching that God comes to you as a gift not as someone you have to work your way up a ladder to get God's favor. The Church is centered around Word and Sacraments not the latest fads or gimmicks. The true treasure of the church is the gospel. The good news is not only that the Lutherans know this. The gospel is for the whole church and the world! ELCA Lutherans are now having prayer gatherings with Catholics and focusing on the gospel. We have partnerships now with the Methodists, Presbyterians, and other Christians. Let us commemorate the Reformation that centers not on our divisions but our unity in Christ. Jesus said," And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." (John 12:32)


